

Marasmius sp 11108

Cap: convex; to 2 mms diameter; white; with prominent setae to 0.25mm on primordia and on cap, setae ochraceous.

Stipe: cylindrical; 4 × 0.5 mms; hyaline, glabrous.

Gills: adnate; white, 14 reach stipe.

Flesh: thin, white, unchanging.

Spores: not seen

Cheilocystidia: not seen

Pileipellis: not seen.

Habitat: growing on leaves of a rainforest tree in wet sclerophyl forest.

Notes: no microscopic details obtained, only one specimen and two primordia.

Appears to be a small spinulose *Marasmius*. Grgurinovic does not list any. Petrini, Petrini and Horak require microscopic details for a determination. Desjardin suggests *Mycena spinosissima* may be a possibility. More collections needed!
