

Mycena sp 21108

Cap: campanulate; up to 3 mms diameter; white with pinkish tone caused by droplets at centre, margin sulcate.

Stipe: cylindrical; 15 - 20 × 0.25 - 0.5 mms; hyaline; bulbous hispid ochraceous base.

Gills: adnexed, white; 10 reaching stipe.

Flesh: very thin, white, unchanging.

Spores: white; subcylindric; 3.5 - 4.5 × 7 - 9 μm; Q = 1.9 - 2.1.

Cheilocystidia:

Caulocystidia: narrowly lageniform, some branching in two, smooth.

Pileipellis: a cutis of elongated acanthocysts 75 - 150 × 12 - 20 μm and disarticulating spaeropedunculate acanthocyst 25 - 35 × 20 - 30 μm.

Habitat: on leaf in wet sclerophyl forest with *Eucalyptus*

Notes: this minute pink *Mycena* does not key readily in Grgurinovic. It appears to fit most readily in the *Adonideae*, but is not *M. wubabulna* which has a different cap cuticle and caulocystidia.
