Cap: applanate with a shallow umbilicus; 25 – 40 mm diameter; finely radially fibrillose; pale yellow brown (5B4); margin striate.

Stipe: cylindrical, tough, leathery; 45 – 60 × 3 – 5 mm; covered in minute white hairs, vertically striate above; very pale cream but with sepia tones in lower half.

Gills: adnate, sometimes with a hint of a collarium; moderately crowded; lamellulae present in 2 series; pale cream.

Flesh: thin, tough, white.

Taste:

Spore print: white.

Spores: not observed.

Basidia: not observed.

Pleurocystidia: not observed.

Pileipellis: a cutis of interwoven hyphae.

Substrate: growing in leaf and twig litter.

Habitat: Wallum, under *Callitris* and *Allocasuarina*.

Notes: keys to *Gymnopus* in FunKey.
