


Gluepot Reserve –typical mallee and casuarina woodland with acacia, senna, saltbush, eremophila understorey......annual rainfall 200mm.

























Where are the Mycorrhizal Fungi and what species are they?














Tulostoma sp. 30-40mm tall, 9-15mm wide










Geastrum sp. gathered from Casuarina woodland
