Cup: cup shaped, 5-8 mm high x 5-7 mm wide, greyish to cinnamon brown External – thick, felt like, velvety, epiphragm is operculate, yellow to ochraceous Internal – smooth, creamy-white, shiny

Peridioles: numerous (10-15), 1.5-2 mm diam., lenticular, pale ochraceous then whitish,, attached to peridium by simple filiform funiculus

Spores: ellipsoid 6-10 x 3.5-5 mu, smooth with slightly thickened wall.

Substrate: wood, twigs, compost

Habitat: woodland, gardens, parks worldwide distribution.
