## Tremella foliacea

**Fruiting body:** 8 - 50 mm radius; this extensively folded and lobed jelly fungus usually has a central point of attachment. Colours vary between brown, orange brown, caramel to reddish-brown. Texture is soft, gelatinized and moist to touch.

**Flesh:** same colours and is thicker when wet. **Spores:** ovoid to ellipsoid,  $9 - 11 \times 6 - 8 \mu m$ .

**Substrate:** wood, living trees. **Habitat:** damp wooded areas.

**Notes:** There are other species of *Tremella*, but none has the combination of prominent leaf like folds and brown orange colours that distinguish this species. **Collections examined:** SMF, Dogrell Track, Kin Kin, Pat Leonard, Apr 2009.
