Pholiota squarrosipes

Cap: convex, some with a shallow central depression; 20 - 60 mm diameter; glabrous and slightly viscid, some minutely fibrillose; light brown (6D5).

Stipe: caespitose; cylindrical; $40 - 50 \times 2 - 5$ mm; glabrous above a ring zone, squarrose below; light brown.

Gills: adnexed or adnate with a decurrent tooth (?); yellowish brown

Flesh: off-white.

Smell:

Spore print: brown.

Spores: ellipsoid; $6.5 - 9 \times 4 - 5 \mu m$; smooth, with a germ pore.

Basidia: clavate; four-spored.

Cheilocystidia: Pleurocystidia:

Pileipellis: an ixocutis with clamp connections.

Habitat: growing in a path through rainforest, possibly on buried wood.

Notes: this collection seems to fit the description of *P. squarrosipes* given by Grgurinovic. However, it has not previously been recorded in Queensland so more collections are needed to confirm this.
