Cap: convex; to 25 mm diameter; yellowish brown;

Stipe: cylindrical; $50 \times 3 - 5$ mm; pale with some yellow-brown reticulate staining,

smooth.

Pores: deeply adnexed, pulling away from stipe to form elongated pores; pinkish

brown.

Flesh: white, not discolouring. Spores: $14 - 17.5 \times 5.5 - 7 \mu m$. Cheilocystidia: not seen Dermatocystidia: not seen Pileipellis: a gelatinised cutis?

Habitat: a solitary specimen growing with *Eucalyptus* in wet sclerophyll forest.

Notes: Described by Watling from a single collection in Cooloola, it is difficult to be

certain whether this collection is of that species. More collections are needed. **Collections examined:** PL 441107, Maroochy Bushland Botanic Garden,
