## Gymnopus sp 'lofty'

**Cap:** Conico-convex; glabrous to innately fibrillose; greyish brown. **Stipe:** cylindrical; striate; pale base

with greyish brown fibres.

**Gills:** adnexed; pale fawn, pinkish fawn; lamellulae present in one series.

Flesh: thin, fibrous; pale fawn.

**Spore print:** white.

**Spores:** globose to subglobose;

 $\pm 7 \mu m$ .

Pileipellis: a cutis.

**Habitat:** in deep litter and possibly

with mulch admixed.

**Notes:** this fungus is noticeable by its very tall fibrillose greyish stipe, white adnexed pale fawn gills and its conico convex cap. It keys to *Gymnopus* but not to any of the species listed by Grgurinovic. The globose spores would be out of place in this genus that mostly has ellipsoid or lachrymose spores.
