

Amaurodon viridis

Fruiting body: resupinate on the underside of small logs. Surface covered with small, raised bumps.

Substrate: small logs.

Habitat: rainforest with Eucalypts.

Notes: very uncertain identification based on image and brief description in Field Guide to Tasmanian Fungi. Cunningham says this species is yellowish green rather than blue!
