Cap: shallowly convex; 60 mm diameter; with small squamules; pale yellowish brown squames on a cream background.

Stipe: cylindrical with a bulbous base; glabrous with a few fine fibres; white; annulus half way down stipe; white, pendulous with a dark edge; has rhizoids.

Gills: free; crowded; with lamellulae in one series; pale greyish pink at first becoming pale chocolate.

Flesh: white, neither reddening nor yellowing.

Smell: agaricoid.

Spore print: chocolate.
