

*Dictyopanus pusillus*

**Pileus:** weakly convex, round to kidney-shaped; 2–5 mm diameter; smooth but appears velvety under a lens; cream, pale fawn to buff.

**Stem:** lateral, reduced; 1–8 × 0.5–1 mm; minutely velvety; pale fawn.

**Pores:** about 3 per mm; usually round but may be radially elongated towards the stem.

**Spore print:** white.

**Spores:** ellipsoid; 4–5.5 × 2–3 µm; smooth, hyaline.

**Substrate:** wood, including wooden outdoor furniture.

**Habitat:** forests and woodlands.

**Notes:** this pored fungus is easily recognised by its small size, shape, attachment and colour. This species is also known as *Panellus pusillus*.
