Donna has conducted surveys on a weekly basis for a year in Purga Nature Reserve, Ipswich. She discovered 71 species, including almost 30 mycorrhizal fungi. Purga protects the endangered species *Melaleuca irbyana*.

Donna explored the connections she has made between art and science in this project and her talk was enjoyed by all present.
